Award Categories and Nomination Guidelines

E. Boyd Graves Preservation Award

...for Excellence in Historic Preservation

Award Description: The *E. Boyd Graves Preservation Award of Excellence* provides public recognition for the preservation achievements of individuals, groups, and others in an effort to encourage greater awareness and support for the preservation of our shared cultural heritage. Awards are generally given to specific preservation projects deemed to contribute to the understanding, appreciation, and protection of the history of the Fredericksburg, Virginia region.

Nomination Submission Deadline:

Project nominations should be submitted to the offices of the Historic Fredericksburg Foundation, Inc. no later than February 5th of the current award year. (Extended to February 10th, 2018 for 2017 nominations.)

Eligibility Requirements / Nomination Guidelines:

- **1)** To be eligible for the *E. Boyd Graves Preservation Award for Excellence*, the nominated project must meet the following minimum requirements:
 - ✓ Project must be completed sometime between Jan. 1 and Dec. 31 of the year immediately preceding the current award year. [i.e. To receive the 2017 E. Boyd Graves Award, nominated project must have been completed sometime between January 1, 2017 and December 31, 2017]

NOTE: Projects still ongoing after Dec. 31 of the year immediately preceding the current award year are not eligible.

✓ Any completed work should comply with the Secretary of the Interior's (SOI) Guidelines Regarding Preservation / Rehabilitation / Renovation / Restoration of Historic Buildings

Examples of Past HFFI E. Boyd Graves Preservation Award for Excellence:

1. ### Hanover Street

Excellence in restoration of historic duplex. Using Tidewater Preservation, the owners restored many original attributes of one-half of historic duplex at the corner of Prince Edward and Hanover Streets.

2. ### Hanover Street

Excellence in sensitive infill and streetscape preservation. The property owners constructed a one-story, brick home across the street from Federal Hill, completed in 2009. The project is a good example of how to construct a modern home in a historic area that blends with the neighborhood character.

3. The ### Caroline Street

Excellence in rehabilitation of historic building. The owners rehabilitated this historic home into three suites for the Richard Johnson Inn. Project included restoring old woodwork and interior details while making accommodations for modern travelers.

4. ### Charles Street

Excellence in home maintenance. The owners hired Habilis Construction, Inc. to complete a thorough and accurate restoration of home's original slate roof.

5. ### Hanover Street

Excellence in building stewardship. The homeowner constructed a sympathetic addition to his historic home on the edge of the historic district through the use of appropriate materials and subsequent landscaping
